Connie Ann Carter of Chestertown, MD went into the loving arms of Jesus on September 30, 2024. She was 75. Born in Cambridge, MD, Connie was the eldest daughter of Connie and Jim Todd. She spent her childhood in downtown Chestertown and graduated from Chestertown High School in 1967 before moving to Baltimore City where she met the love of her life, the late Ross Carter. They married on January 14, 1973, and raised two beautiful children together, eventually settling down in Chestertown, MD.

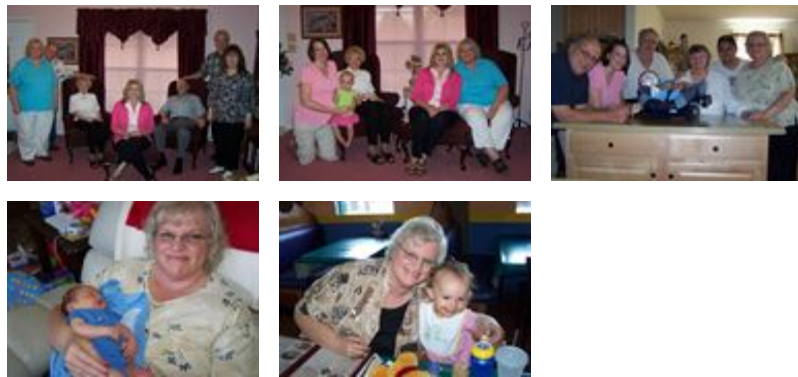
