Connie Turner of Centreville, MD, died on February 9, 2019. She was 78.

Born in Centreville, MD, on June 2, 1940, she was the daughter of the late Orem Mills Middleton, Sr., and Helen Dorrell Middleton. Connie was a 1959 graduate of Centreville High School and, on August 1 of the same year, married her sweetheart James Melvin “Mink” Turner, to whom she was happily married for over 50 years.

The couple made their home in Centreville, and Connie was a full-time homemaker while their children were young. Later, she worked as a substitute teacher and a private home healthcare aide. Connie enjoyed traveling, especially to Nashville, TN, and to Rhode Island to visit friends. She also made time to visit casinos. She dedicated most of her free time to the pleasure of spending time with her grandson, Cody.
