Connor Rice of Queen Anne, MD died suddenly Friday September 16, 2011 in an automobile accident in Centreville, MD. He was 15.

Born on June 27, 1996 in Baton Rouge, LA, the son of Todd and Robin Clark Rice. Connor grew up in Queen Anne, MD where he was active playing youth sports like soccer and little league baseball. He enjoyed Legos and his trips to Lego land and Louisiana over the years, playing computer games, and eating, especially pancakes & crawfish. As a freshman in 2010 he was a member of the Queen Anne's County High School JV soccer team and currently a member of the QACSH JV cross country team. Conner, a gentle sweet soul, will be remembered most for his clever sense of humor and winning smile.

He is survived by his parents, Todd and Robin Rice of Queen Anne, MD; two brothers, Hayden Clark Rice and Nathan James Rice of Queen Anne, MD; maternal grandmother, Mae Clark and the late, James Clark of LA; paternal grandmother, Susannah Rice of NC and paternal grandfather, the late, Robert C. 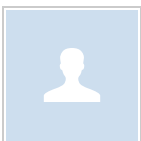

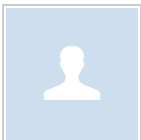
