Constance Marie Johnson of Sudlersville, MD, died on December 15, 2011. She was born in Philadelphia, PA, on July 11, 1917, the daughter of the late Franklin Gill and Myrtle Elizabeth Nebicker (Young) Gill.

Connie grew up in Pennsylvania and during World War II worked as a keypunch operator for RCA Victor. She met Earl Johnson, and they married on June 21, 1947. They moved to Maryland in 1957.

Mrs. Johnson was a homemaker, an accomplished seamstress, and a wonderful cook and baker. She was very artistic, enjoyed painting, and for several years operated a ceramic shop.
