Constantinous M. "Gus" Siachos of Oxford, MD died on Saturday, November 2, 2002 at Montgomery General Hospital, Olney, MD. He was 70.

Born April 11, 1932 on the Island of Crete, Greece, he was the son of the late Michael and Maria Siachos. He was educated in Greece and in 1952 graduated from the College of Athens with a degree in Engineering. After serving in the Greek Navy from 1952 until 1956, he moved to the United States where he worked at the Greek Embassy. From 1958 until his retirement in 1980 he worked at the World Bank in Washington, D.C., under the supervision of Robert McNamara. After retiring, he moved to Oxford, MD where he owned the Pier Street Restaurant until his time of death.

A member of the Sts. Constantine and Helen Greek Orthodox Church in Annapolis, MD, was concerned about the welfare of his community and the feelings of others.

Mr. Siachos is survived by his wife, the former Anna Doufas, whom he married in 1960 in Washington, D.C.; three children, Michael C. Siachos and his wife, Debbie of Oxford, MD, Joanne S. Patchett and her husband, Tyler of Oxford, MD and Louise S. Stroke and her husband, John of Frederick, MD; a brother, Stavros of Naples, FL and two grandchildren, Katie Patchett and Tyler Patchett.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday, November 7, 2002 at 11:00 AM at Sts. Constantine and Helen Greek Orthodox Church, Annapolis, MD.
