October 30, 1946 - August 19, 2011

Conwell Brittingham passed away peacefully on Friday, August 19th at the Memorial Hospital at Easton, after a brief battle with cancer. He was 64 years old.

Born October 30, 1946, he was the son of the late, Thomas J. and Mary V. Johnson Brittingham.

On May 29, 1971 he married his sweetheart, the former Brenda Ayers. He then served three years in the Army after being drafted.
