Cornelia Hall Lewis of Easton, MD died on Saturday October 14, 2006 at Talbot Hospice House, Easton. She was 84.

Born December 27, 1921 in Newcomb, MD, she was the daughter of Sarah McQuay and Cardiff R. Hall. She graduated from St. Michael's High School in 1940 and was a life member of the Alumni Association. Her greatest enjoyment was working with children and the mentally handicapped. She operated Neil's Day Care for several years, worked for the Board of Education in Special Education in Talbot and Caroline Counties, and also for the Chesapeake Developmental Unit for 10 years.

A lifetime member of VFW Ladies Auxiliary Post 5118, she was also a member of the Ladies Auxiliary American Legion Post 70 and a Charter Member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church in Easton.

Her husband of 53 years, A. Carl Lewis, passed away on October 3, 1993.
