Charles Palmer “Jimmy” Lane of Ridgely, MD, formerly of Chester, MD, died at his home on Sunday, December 12, 2004. He was 76.

Born October 18, 1928 in Stevensville, MD, he was the son the of the late Charles and Loretta Porter Lane. He attended school in Chester, MD. He worked with the Lowery Farm and then went to refrigeration school in Mergentholer School in Baltimore, MD. He started in business with Jerry Pierson in Chester, MD and in 1967 he went into business for himself as Lane’s Refrigeration and Heating. This later evolved into Lane’s Excavation. Following his retirement, Mr. Lane drove trucks part time for Harris Seafood in Grasonville, MD On February 12, 1955 he married the former Bernice Gardner and they would have been married 50 years this February.

Mr. Lane volunteered with Grasonville VFW and other community events.
