Curtis Paul Byington of Seaford, DE died at his home on February 19, 2018. He was 54.

Born in Baltimore, MD On July 9, 1963, he was the son of the late George and Ola Mae Byington. He grew up in Talbot County and graduated from St. Michaels High School in the Class of 1981.
