



## Curtis Charles Jacquette

March 8, 1922 - August 1, 2014

Curtis Charles Jacquette, Sr., of Rock Hall, MD, died Friday, August 1, 2014, at Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown. He was 92.

Mr. Jacquette was born on March 8, 1922, the son of the late James Leroy and Irene Emma Metcalf Jacquette.

He graduated from Rock Hall High School and served in the U. S. Army. Upon his honorable discharge, he returned home to Rock Hall where he earned his living as a bricklayer and mason.

He was predeceased by his wife, Dorothy "Pat" Jacquette, on July 1, 2003; he was also preceded in death by five brothers and a sister, Isabell.

Mr. Jacquette enjoyed gardening, fixing and repairing things, crabbing, bird watching, and watching sunsets.
