



## Cynthia Louise Hathaway

November 19, 1947 - November 3, 2021

On November 3, 2021, Cynthia L. Hathaway (age 73) passed away after a long and relatively healthy life (except at the end). She wrote this obituary and instructed her family not to mess with it.
