



## Daisey Elizabeth Dill

September 27, 1928 - July 15, 2024

Daisey E. Dill of Smyrna, DE, passed away peacefully and went home to the lord on July 15, 2024, at the age of 95.

Born in Price, Maryland, on September 27, 1928, Daisey was the daughter of the late Herbert and Martha Jarrell. She attended Centreville Elementary School and Church Hill High School.

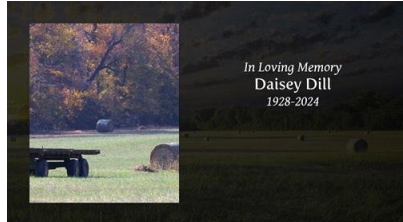
