Daniel Lee Garvin of Marydel, MD died Friday, June 19, 2009 in the Chester River Hospital Center, Chestertown, MD. He was 45 years old. Mr. Garvin was born in Portsmouth Ohio and is the son of Darwin D. Garvin of Caldwell, Ohio and Bertha Townsend Garvin of Millington, MD.

He is a retired Maryland Natural Resources' Police Officer retiring in 2001.

Mr. Garvin was a member of the Fraternal Order of Police, The Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation, and a Life member of the National Rifle Association. Mr. Garvin was a member of the Immaculate Conception Catholic Church, Marydel, MD and a Member of the Knights of Columbus, Our Lady of Guadalupe Council.
