January 8, 1984 - June 7, 2008

Daniel “Danny” Stephen Rosemary of Preston, MD, died on Saturday, June 7, 2008. He was 24.

Born January 8, 1984, in Preston, MD, he was the son of Edward Charles and Veronica Ann Morris Rosemary. He was a 2002 graduate of Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic High School in Easton. He then served in the U.S. Marine Corp from 2003 to 2007, where he rose to the rank of Sergeant and served as Organizational Automotive Mechanic. He was also in the non-resident program and earned his tan belt, gray belt and green belt in martial arts. He received the following, medals, decorations, citations and campaign ribbons; Marine Corps Good Conduct Medal, Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, Sea Service Deployment Ribbon, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Navy Unit Commendation, Certificate of Appreciation, Rifle Expert Badge and Pistol Expert Badge. Following his release from active duty, he worked as a diesel mechanic in North Carolina.

He was a member of St. Peter & Paul Catholic Church, in Easton, MD.

In addition to his parents, Danny is survived by one brother, Kevin Matthew Rosemary of Preston; maternal grandparents, Wesley and Betty A. Taylor of Preston; and numerous aunts, uncles and cousins. He was predeceased by his paternal grandparents, Edward and Clara Rosemary, and maternal

grandfather, Henry A. Morris.

A Funeral Liturgy will be celebrated at Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church, Easton, MD on Friday, June 13, 2008, at 11:00 AM.
