



Daniel A. Walsworth

March 22, 1920 - November 16, 2013

Daniel Reuben Walsworth died on Saturday, November 16, 2013, at William Hill Manor in Easton, MD. He was 93.

Mr. Walsworth was born on March 22, 1920, in Jonesboro, LA, the son of Thomas and Ola Pope Walsworth. He enlisted in the United States Navy in 1939 and served with distinction for six years. When the war ended, he was a chief petty officer.

He resided in northern New Jersey for most of his adult life. He was married on February 12, 1945, to Elizabeth Bertha Gueth. They lived together happily until her death in 2008.

Mr. Walsworth was a career milk man and owned his own business for several years. He loved his work because he loved serving people. He attended Parsippany Presbyterian Church where he served as a deacon and an usher. He and his wife moved to Dover, DE, in 2007 to an assisted living facility. After his wife died in 2008, he relocated to an assisted living facility in Easton to be closer to his immediate family.

Mr. Walsworth will be missed by all who knew him for he was a kind and compassionate man.

Mr. Walsworth is survived by a son, Craig T. Walsworth, of St. Michaels, MD, several grandchildren, and great-grandchildren.

A funeral service will be held at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 200 S. Harrison St. in Easton, on Tuesday, November 26 at 11 a.m., where friends may call one hour prior to the service.
