Daniel James Whitzel passed away on September 26, 2017, at age 80. He was born in Baltimore, MD, the son of deceased parents, James and Ruth Phillips Whitzel and deceased brother, Jerry Whitzel.

Daniel graduated from Mergenthaler Technical High School in Baltimore and served in the United States Navy aboard the U.S.S. Lexington for four years. He was a mechanical designer by profession and in 1976 moved the family to Easton. He retired from Choptank Electric Cooperative in Denton, MD.

Dan was an avid weightlifter all of his life and won many awards in both power lifting and body building. He became Chairman of the Weightlifting Committee at the Easton YMCA and helped many young people develop fitness programs based on their individual needs. He enjoyed artwork, woodworking and was an archer, making his own bows and arrows. Dan also enjoyed all creatures great and small.

Dan is survived by his beloved wife of 57 years, Beverly, of Easton and his children, Dale of Easton, Michael of Tucson, AZ, Pam Showacre of Preston, Susan of Cordova, and Jeffrey (Tracy) of Easton. He was the proud grandfather of 10 grandchildren; one deceased, Todd Whitzel; 13 great-grandchildren; dear friends; and his dog, Vicki.

A visitation will be held on Wednesday, October 4, 2017, from 10 AM -12 PM, at St. Mark's United Methodist Church, 100 Peachblossom Rd., Easton. The funeral service will follow at 12 PM.
