Daniel Hendrickson Wellford died with his family by his side at his home in Oxford, MD after a long illness. he was born in Woodbury, NJ on April 5, 1926, but was raised in Wilmington, DE. He served in the US Army for three years during WWII, after graduating from the Episcopal High School in Alexandria, Virginia. Following the war, he received his B.S. degree in chemistry from the University of Virginia, where he was a member of the St. Anthony Club. He briefly worked for the DuPont Company as a chemist before being hired by Pan American World Airways. After 30 years of service, he retired as a 747 captain.

An avid sailor and outdoorsman, he cruised extensively with his wife, the former Sandra Shettle, whom he married in 1976, and their dogs. He was a member of the Tred Avon Yacht Club, the Chesapeake bay Yacht Club and the Cruising Club of America.

As well as his wife sandy, he is survived by his children, Renee,Caroline,Daniel,Jr and Polly, a step-son George, eight grandchildren, a great-granddaughter, his brother Beverly and sister Virginia.
