Daniel “Dan” John Jonczak of Centreville, MD died at his home on Monday, December 10, 2007. He was 81.

Born April 29, 1926 in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late James and Elsie Liszewski Jonczak. After graduating from high school he entered the U.S. Marine Corps in March 1944. He was a machinist and rifle marksman serving in the Pacific Theatre of Operations in the 4th Marine Division and was honorably discharged in 1946. In 1960 he began working with the Baltimore City Police Dept. and retired in 1974 following 14 years of service. Later that year he worked at Chesapeake College in the security office and retired as Head of Security. On February 20, 1977 he married the former Barbara Edge of Centreville, MD.

He loved his family. He enjoyed fishing, crabbing, boating and anything to do with the water and his son, Wayne was always by his side.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Jonczak is survived by a son, Wayne Daniel Jonczak of Centreville, MD; a daughter, Michelle Jonczak of Centreville, MD; a step-son, Ronnie Edge and his wife, Kim, of Chestertown, MD; four brothers, Stanley Jonczak and Melvin Jonczak, both of Baltimore, Richard Jonczak of Grasonville, MD and Joey Jonczak of Stevensville, MD; two grandchildren, Ronnie Jr. and Michele and one great grandchild, Amarian. He

was pre-deceased by a step-son, Billy Tyler Fooks and two sisters, Angie Purcel and Delores Ewing.
