



## Daphne M. Brownell

July 17, 1918 - November 14, 2017

Daphne M Brownell, 99, of Rock Hall, MD, died on November 14, 2017 at her son's and daughter-in-law's home in Rock Hall, MD. She was born in New York and was a long-time resident of DeLand, FL, where she received her BA and MA degrees from Stetson University. She also received an MS degree in Library Science from Catholic University in Washington, DC. In July 2006, she moved from Florida to Rock Hall, MD, to be closer to her family.

Mrs. Brownell was active in many organizations including the American Assoc. of University Women; Col. Arthur Ervin Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR), and James Emery Society of the Colonial Dames of the 17th Century. For many years she was a member of the DeLand Library Board.

Mrs. Brownell was a librarian and a certified Genealogy Searcher. She collected materials relating to the families of Andover, Independence, and Whitesville, NY, and to DeLand and West Volusia County, FL. She donated the materials to the Hinkle Library at Alfred University, Alfred, NY and to the DeLand Public Library.

Mrs. Brownell was pre-deceased by her sister, Barbara Martin. She is survived by her son, Richard, and his wife Sandra; three grandchildren, Colleen, Corey and Alysia; two great-grandchildren, Zachary and Riley; her nephew Bryan and his wife Christa; her great-nephew, Christopher and her

niece, Clara.
