D. Glenn Gaultney of Easton, Md., died at his home, on Friday, October 14, 2005. He was 76.

Born March 9, 1925 in Banner Elk, North Carolina, he was the son of the late Dayton Leonard and Mattie Barlow Gaultney. Following graduation from Cranberry High School in North Carolina, he then entered the U.S. Army. While in the Army he served on the front lines as a machine gunner for two years during the Korean conflict. Following his release from active duty he began a lifelong career in the drywall business, and also founded Faith Building Supplies in Easton in 1972. He retired in 1987 due to disability.

He was a member of the First Wesleyan Church of Easton, where he served as a Board Member, Trustee, building Committee for the Family Life Center and other various committees.

Mr. Gaultney was an avid sportsman; he enjoyed golf, and was very active in the Maryland State Archery Tournaments.
