



## Darrell Lee Furnish

Darrell Lee Furnish of Easton, died at the Veterans Medical Center, Baltimore, on Thursday March 7, 2002. He was 62.

Born on August 16, 1939 in Oceola, Iowa he was the son of the late Kenneth C. and Irene Siegfried Furnish. After graduating from Easton High School in 1957 he attended the University of Baltimore, where he received a degree in business management in 1965. He then joined the United States Air Force, serving two tours of duty in Vietnam as a B-52 navigator. He was Honorably discharged in 1970 with the rank of Captain having been awarded the Air Medal with two oak leaf clusters for his participation in combat missions.

Following his release from active duty he returned to Maryland where he worked as a supervisor for the General Electric Company in Laurel. After retiring in 1985 he returned to Easton where he worked at various places.

He was a member of the Presbyterian Church of Easton, where he served as an Elder, head usher, adult Sunday School Teacher and tutor for the after school program. He was also a member of the Talbot Partnership first night committee, a founding member of True Colors and a member of the United Fund of Talbot County.

Mr. Furnish is survived by a sister, Carol Sue Clark of St. Michaels; 6 nieces

and nephews, and 4 great-nieces and nephews. A brother Kenneth C. Furnish Jr. and a sister Lois F. Swing are deceased.

A memorial service will be held on Monday, March 18, 2002 at 3:00PM at the Presbyterian Church 617 N. Washington St., Easton.

Burial will be private.
