Daryl L Weaver passed away peacefully at his home surrounded by family on March 21, 2025. He was a kind man and a true friend to all who knew him. Born in Easton, MD on December 8, 1945, to the late J. Lewis Weaver and Lois B. Jackson of Bozman MD. He graduated from St. Michaels High School in 1963. He then served in the United States Coast Guard from 1963-1967. Upon discharge, Daryl pursued his passion for the outdoors and wildlife when he began his career with the Department of Natural Resources Police in 1967, retiring after 23 years. Daryl enjoyed retirement by living life to the fullest and spending time with his loving wife, Jean.
