David Henry Baynard, 68, passed away on Tuesday, December 10, 2019, at his home in Trappe, MD, following a lengthy illness, and surrounded by his loving family.

Born on February 5, 1951, in Easton, MD, Dave was the son of James Henry Baynard and Rosemary Adams Baynard. He was the grandson of Dudley and Lillie Baynard, and Maurice and Erva Adams. Dave attended schools in Trappe and Easton. He graduated from Easton High School, and was a proud member of the Class of '69, recently attending their 50-year class reunion.

On June 12, 1971, Dave married his wife of 48 years, the former Debbie Gray, of Cambridge, and together they raised two wonderful daughters, Allison Rosenthal (Kevin) of Easton, and Julie Trommatter (Matthew) of Trappe.
