David Osmond Brown of Rock Hall, MD, died on December 1, 2001, at Kent and Queen Anne's Hospital in Chestertown, MD. He was 73.

Born in Brooklyn, NY, and raised in Hastings on Hudson, NY, he was the son of the late B. Osmond and Emily Breitenstein Brown. He was the husband of Tish Carnes Brown of Rock Hall, MD.

Mr. Brown was a 1949 graduate of Lehigh University where he majored in Chemical Engineering. He was a member of Beta Theta Pi Fraternity. During the Korean War, he served as lieutenant in the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

Mr. Brown was most recently employed by Rohm and Haas Chemical Company in Philadelphia. He and his wife retired to Rock Hall in 1997. Mr. Brown's interests included sailing, woodworking, and sculpting. He was a member of Emmanuel Episcopal Church in Chestertown.

In addition to his wife of 23 years, he is survived by three daughters: Lori Tobin, Stephanie Renino, and Tracey Hickey; and six grandchildren, all of New York.

Services will be held on Thursday, December 6, 2001, at 11 a.m. at Emmanuel Episcopal Church in Chestertown. Interment will be in St. Paul's

Cemetery near Rock Hall.
