David Bruce Kerr of Chester, MD, died suddenly from cardiac arrest on Tuesday, February 17, 2004, in Chester, MD. He was 54.

Born November 4, 1949, in Syracuse, NY, he was the son of the late Henry Kaye and Ruth Fite Kerr. He graduated from Jamesville Dewitt High School in Syracuse, NY in 1968. He moved to Annapolis in 1975 and began working as a custom yacht carpenter at Dockside Yacht Sales in Annapolis, MD. He established Kerr Carpentry, a home improvement business, where he worked on all types of construction. He later worked in sales at Fuller Motors, The Cedar Co., and Johnson Lumber Co.

In 1980, he moved to Kent Island. Dave was a gifted fisherman and an avid boater, and he also enjoyed skiing, woodworking and reading.

He is survived by three sons, Christopher D. Kerr of Salisbury, MD; Kevin N. Kerr and Kenneth C. Kerr, both of Centreville, MD; two brothers, Charles F. Kerr of Grand Junction, CO, and J. Craig Kerr of Syracuse, NY.
