



## David George Draut

July 21, 1935 - December 2, 2024

David G. Draut passed away on December 2, 2024, in Easton, Maryland. He was 89 years old and lived in Londonderry where he was an active member of the community.

David was born on July 21, 1935, to Ralph H. Draut and Iva Nicholson Draut in Troy, Ohio. His father was an engineer in the early world of aeronautics causing the family to move a number of times in pursuit of that career. David developed his considerable affection for this area after spending most of his formative years in Kingsville, Maryland. He graduated from The University of Maryland in 1960 followed by a tour of duty in the U.S. Army where he was assigned to the Redstone missile program in Huntsville, Al. David began his career teaching in Baltimore County Public Schools. Later he worked for corporations such as the Glenn L. Martin Co.

In 1966, he relocated to Georgia to work for Lockheed-Georgia on the C-5A transport project. He subsequently earned a degree from the Georgia Institute of Technology leading to a thirty year career in civil engineering, working mostly in Georgia as a registered engineer. David worked for a number of city and county governments and spent the last ten years of his career with a small consulting firm helping small towns and cities design and develop expansions or improvements to their waste water systems as well as obtain project funding. He was a member of the American Society of Civil Engineers

and the Water Environment Federation among other professional associations.

David and his wife, Mary Ann, retired to Maryland in 2002 and settled in Easton. His wife preceded him in death in 2011. He was also preceded in death by his two sister, Patricia Allen of Easton and Phyllis Vanderslice of Eugene, Oregon. He leaves behind a niece and nephew as well as his companion, Brenda Crabbs.
