David E. Geib, a great man, was met at the gates of heaven by family and friends on January 25, 2013, at Talbot Hospice House in Easton, MD. He was 83.

He was born in Trappe, MD, on March 27, 1929, to the late Jacob and Thelma Fike Geib. Mr. Geib attended local schools and later joined the Navy in 1946. He served until he was honorably discharged in 1948. He was a jack of all trades and skilled in many things from truck driving to mechanics to carpentry work. He retired from Wesco Services in 1995.

He married Audrey Nichols on July 23, 1948, and they had six children. David built their family home in Cordova in 1959. David and Audrey were members of the Easton Church of the Brethren.
