David Lee Hathway of Stevensville, MD died at his home on October 18, 2012. He was 75.

Born on January 6, 1937 in Watertown, NY, he was the son of the late, Leon and Marion Hathway, Dave was raised in Harrisville, NY. He is survived by his beloved children, Keith, Kenneth and Laurie, and their spouses, a brother, Phil Hathway, 7 grandchildren and 3 great grandchildren. In his early years he loved to hunt, and spend time with family and friends at his hunting Camp in the Adirondacks. Dave was an avid outdoorsman who appreciated all that nature had to offer. He was a sports fan devoted to the

Orioles and Ravens.
