David James Joynes of Grasonville died Tuesday, November 18, 2003 at Memorial Hospital in Easton, MD. He was 95.

Born on April 20, 1908 in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late David J. and Lillian Schneider Joynes. David attended school in Baltimore and later he became a Mechanic with Miller Motors and other establishments thru the 1920's. In 1932 he served with the Merchant Marines on the "S.S. City of Norfolk" through 1936 when he returned to Baltimore and on August 20, 1936 he married Madeline Theresa Tyler. He then worked for Bethlehem Steel where he retired in 1971. Following his retirement, David and Madeline moved to the Eastern Shore of Maryland, Grasonville. Mrs. Joynes predeceased him on February 15, 1996.

Mr. Joynes is survived by two sons, David J. Joynes III and his wife Joyce and John H. Joynes, all of Grasonville, MD; a half brother, Henry Sinsz of Cape May, NJ; three grandchildren Deborah L. Becker, Donna M. Olsen and Joanne D. Lanphar and 12 great grandchildren.
