David Mears, Jr. of Stevensville died Tuesday, January 6, 2004 at his residence. He was 79.

Born on December 20, 1924 in Silver Spring, MD, he was the son of the late David Mears, Sr. and the late Lottie D. Kramer Mears. He grew up in Silver Spring, MD. During WWII, he served in the U.S. Army in Normandy, France and Rhineland where he received a purple heart, good conduct medal, distinguished unit badge, European African Middle eastern Theater Ribbon and the World War II Victory Ribbon.

He worked several years for the Washington Post as route manager and later worked for American Tobacco Co. and 3M Technologies as a sales representative. In the 1960's he moved to St. Michaels and worked for ALCO Structures in Easton. During this time he served as commodore of St. Michael's Yacht Club. Mr. Mears moved to Manassas, VA and worked for American Trust and later returned to the Eastern Shore in Stevensville, working for Southern Lithoplate as a sales representative. He was a member of the American Legion Post #278 and had been President of the Kent Cove Homeowner's Association for ten years.

Mr. Mears is survived by one son, David Michael Mears of Sanford, FL; one daughter, Patricia M. Abell of Waldorf, MD; one sister, Sue Maloney of Silver

Spring, MD; five grandchildren and a dear friend, Janice Harrington of
Stevensville, MD
