David Allan Newberry, Sr. of Chester, MD, died on December 24, 2016. He was 74 years old.

Born on April 9, 1942, in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of Walter L. Sr. and Ruth G. Hamilton Newberry.

He grew up in Baltimore and graduated from City College High School in 1960. He graduated Towson University with a Business Administration and Health and Hygiene degree. He was an Eagle Scout recipient.

David moved to Chester, MD with the love of his life, Mary Arlene Newberry. They were sealed for time and eternity in the Washington, DC, LDS temple on September 2, 1978.

He started Captain Dave's Cleaning Service, after retiring from Johns Hopkins Hospital as a Degree Technician. In his spare time, he loved to collect mermaids, go on trips with his family, and participate in LDS church activities.

He was a 32 degree Mason and a member of Boumi Temple in Baltimore. Dave was a 1st Class Hospital Corpsman serving with the 6th Marine Battalion. He was a member of American Legion Post 278 and the VFW Grasonville Eastern Shore. Mr. Newberry was ordained as a High Priest in the

Melchizedek Priesthood of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints.

David is survived by his wife, Mary Arlene Newberry; five children, David Newberry Jr. (Ashley) of Preston, Ruth Newberry-Wilson (Greg) of Midlothian, Angel Harkness (Mike) of Owings, James Newberry and Christina Werelius of Chester; grandchildren, Aniston Newberry, Madison & Corie Harkness, Renee Werelius, and Rachel Sparks; and one brother, Lin Newberry (Traudel) of Carney.

A funeral service will be at 12:30 PM, on Wednesday December 28, 2016, at Church of Jesus Christ and Latter Day Saints in Chester, MD, where a visitation will be held from 11:00 AM to 12:00 PM prior to the service. Burial will follow the service in Woodlawn Memorial Park.

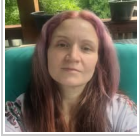

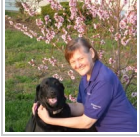
