David N. Norcross, Jr. of Chestertown, Maryland died on December 29, 2010 at Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown, MD. He was 63.

He was born in Montgomery County, Pennsylvania the son of the late, Edwin and Anna Betty White Bruzas. Following graduation from High School, Mr. Norcross served two tours in Vietnam with the U.S. Navy. He was honorably discharged, returned to the states and attended woodworking schools. He became an accomplished woodcarver. He enjoyed cooking and construction, was most proud of his woodcarving skills carving birds and ships, and loved being around friends, relatives, and joking with people. He also was enamored by the Mayan and Peruvian Indians and their extraordinary buildings. Mr. Norcross co-owned and operated the Old Oars Inn in Rock Hall with his mother for many years. He later worked with Tolchester Marina for several years.

He was predeceased by his parents and a son and is survived by two children, five grandchildren, and four great grandchildren.
