



## David Newell Weise

August 1, 1926 - September 28, 2015

David Newell Weise died on Monday, September 28, 2015, at Bayleigh Chase in Easton. He was 89.

Born on August 1, 1926, in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late William A. and Mabelle Newell Weise.

David graduated from Sparrows Point High School in Baltimore, MD. He then served in the Army Air Force during World War II.

He married the former Helen Phipps on October 26, 1949 in Baltimore, MD. David worked as an optician at Bowen & King Optical in Baltimore. He then moved to Easton and began working at Pensel & Walker Inc., eventually buying the business.

David was a member of Christ Church of St. Peter's Parish in Easton, where he served as a Vestry member, Finance Committee member, and an usher.

Mr. Weise enjoyed volunteering on numerous projects in Talbot County, traveling with his wife, and spending time with his children and grandchildren. David also enjoyed working for his grandson's lawn mowing business, "DEW" as an unpaid and always available employee.

David is survived by his wife of 65 years, Helen Weise; his children, William D.
