David F. Wendig of Henderson, MD died Friday, May 23, 2014 at Easton Memorial Hospital in Easton, MD. He was 77.

David was born June 8, 1936 in Doylestown, PA the son of the late Edward Wendig and Mary Wiggins Dreggors. After attending school at Deland High School in DeLand, FL he enlisted in the United States Army where he was stationed in Germany and served proudly for several years before an honorable discharge.
