David E. Wolcott, 66, passed away on Thursday, August 6, 2015, at the Palliative Care Unit of University of Maryland Shore Regional Health with his family at his side.

David was born on February 5, 1949, in Easton MD, the son of the late William E. Wolcott and Lydia J. Wolcott. He graduated from Saints Peter and Paul High School in 1966 and was a civil engineer by trade. In 1979 he married the love of his life, Connie M. Wolcott, and they enjoyed 36 years of marriage before her passing in April of this year.

David was an active member of the Easton Elks Lodge #1622, serving as Exalted Ruler, District Deputy Grand Exalted Ruler, President of the MD, DE, DC Association and was the current Secretary at the time of his death. His adopted motto "Growth Through Service" defines his life.

David is survived by his brother, Michael Kevin Wolcott; his sister, Molly Wolcott Starkey; nieces, Andria Starkey and Jami Shafer; nephew, Adam Starkey; mother-in-law, Betty J. Meredith; and brother-in-law, Jim Meredith (Sharon) and many special loved friends and family.
