David Arthur Horning, of Trappe and formerly of Pittsburgh, PA, died at The Memorial Hospital At Easton, MD on Saturday, April 7, 2001. He was 72.

Born in Beaver Falls, PA, October 4, 1928, he was the son of the late Roy A. and Marguerite Swits Horning. After graduating from The Hill School in 1946, he attended Lehigh University where he received his Bachelor of Science Degree in Civil Engineering in 1950. He then studied Architecture at the Carnegie Institute of Technology. During his business career, he was associated with the H. H. Robertson Co. of Pittsburgh, a worldwide architectural construction supply company, from 1953 until retiring in 1990.

Prior to moving to Trappe in February of 1993, he had lived in Pittsburgh, PA where he was a member and past president of the Pittsburgh Rotary Club. At the time of his death, he was President of the St. Mark's Ministry to the Aged in Easton, a member and President of the Board of Governors of the Talbot Country Club, a senior active member of the Easton Rotary Club, a Paul Harris Fellow of Rotary International and a member of the Bay Country Chorus and St. Mark's United Methodist Church in Easton..

He loved playing golf and sailing and enjoyed life and making friends.

Mr. Horning is survived by his wife, the former Susan Moedinger whom he married in Lancaster, PA on June 21, 1952; three sons, David A. Horning, Jr. and his wife, Mary of Pittsburgh, PA, Paul R. Horning and his wife, Lori of Devon, PA. and Andrew B. Horning and his wife, Lisa of Berwyn, PA; a sister, Lois H. Moyer of St. Michaels, MD; three brothers, Richard Horning of Pioneer, CA, Andrew Horning of Carmel, CA and Arthur Horning, Pacific Grove, CA and five grandchildren, Katelyn, C. J., Molly, Julianna and Blair Horning.

Memorial services will be held on Saturday, April 14th, at 11 A.M. at St. Mark's United Methodist Church, Easton. Burial will be private.
