David Eugene Milburn of Easton, MD died on Saturday, August 2, 2008 at Genesis Healthcare – The Pines, Easton. He was 88.

Born March 14, 1920 in Comus, MD, he was the son of the late Ralph and Annie E. Gregg Milburn. During World War II he served in the U.S. Army. He then returned to the Baltimore area, where he had grown up, and worked for Baltimore Gas & Light. In 1949 he moved to Easton, MD where in 1950 he began working for Easton Utilities. He held positions as a draftsman and supervisor of the water and sewer department, retiring in 1981. During the 1960's he was owner of Guns Unlimited in Easton.

He was a member of the National Rifle Association and the Talbot Rod and Gun Club.

Mr. Milburn is survived by his wife, Alma Milburn, whom he married March 9, 1946; four children, Lawrence E. Milburn and his wife Susie of Bel Air, MD, Robert Milburn of Easton, MD, Shelly Milburn of Daytona Beach, FL, and Lisa Mann of Ft. Pierce, FL; four grandchildren, Michelle Wood and her husband Ben, Heather Moore and her husband Scott, Lucas Milburn, and Shannon Stoll; and seven great-grandchildren.
