



David Llyod Steel Sr.

David Lloyd Steel, Sr., 79, a broadcast consulting engineer, died following an extended illness due to end stage renal disease on July 9, 2001 in Annapolis, Maryland. Mr. Steel an Iowa native, served in the Navy during World War II in the submarine service aboard the U.S.S. R-1 and later on the U.S.S. Beaver. Following the War he moved to Washington, DC to begin his career as a broadcast consulting engineer.

Mr. Steel maintained offices in Washington, DC under the auspices of Page, Creutz, Steel & Waldschmidt, Steel Andrus & Adair and David Steel & Associates, Inc. He was a registered Professional Engineer in the District of Columbia, a former member of the IEEE, The National Association of Broadcasters (NAB) and a member of the Association of Federal Communications Consulting Engineers (AFCCE), serving as President in 1962 – 1963. Mr. Steel represented numerous AM, FM, TV, ITFS and MDS applicants and operating stations throughout the United States in engineering matters before the Federal Communications Commission (FCC).

In the late 1960's Mrs. Steel moved to the Eastern Shore of Maryland and was a founding member and Chairman of the Queen Anne's County Economic Development Commission. He was also a member of VFW Post 7464 in Grasonville, Maryland. Mr. Steel moved to Annapolis in the late 1990's, continuing his consulting business David Steel & Associates, Inc. until

retirement due to ill health in December 2000.

His wife of 50 years, Bernice (Betty) Dorothy Steel, died in 1991.

Survivors include four children, David L. Steel, Jr. of Washington, DC, Terry Steel of Annapolis, MD, Meredith M. Steel of Chester, MD and Peter A. Steel of Chester, MD; two sisters; two brothers; and five grandchildren.
