David Rinde Paulson of Chestertown, MD formerly of Landenberg, PA, died on April 1, 2010 at Heron Point. He was 76.

He was born on April 10, 1933 in Niagara Falls, NY the son of the late, Paul Melvin Paulson and Grace Margaret Miller Paulson. He graduated from Media High School class of 1951. Mr. Paulson served in the Army for two years at Fort Benning, GA. In 1951 he began working for DuPont where he built and installed the first Kevlar Machines for DuPont Wilmington Shops. After retiring in 1992, Mr. Paulson cofounded Paragon Precision, a company that performed optical alignment services for industrial machinery. He enjoyed fabricating tools and parts to create an tool or a machine. In his home, none of his equipment was computerized. The old fashioned way of precise measurement and creativity was paramount in his preparation. Mr. Paulson built his own home with the exception of items he found most important that a specialist perform.

Mr. Paulson for many years enjoyed hunting and fishing. He also enjoyed working on his computer and traveling.

He is predeceased by a brother, John W. Paulson and a grandson, Josiah Gale Davidson.

He is survived by his wife of 54 years, Phyllis Louise Paulson; daughters,

Susan Faye Mitchell of Lynchburg, VA and Linda Louise Davidson of Millington, MD; grandchildren, Jayme Lin Davidson Stoltzfus, Jay Clement Davidson, and Jacob Rinde Davidson; and a great granddaughter, Megan Lin Stoltzfus. Also survived by a sister, Sue Paulson Wilson of North Carolina.

Services will be held on Wednesday April 7, 2010 at 11 AM at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home in Chestertown, MD where friends and family may call one hour prior (10 to 11 AM).
