David W. Wagner died on May 12, 2007 at the Genesis Health Care the Pines. He was 88.

Born on May 9, 1919, in Sandorn, Indiana, he was the son of the late Joy and William Wagner. He was the third of nine children. In 1942 while stationed at Fort Bliss, TX, he married his wife the former, Winona Luciele Darley of Mcleansboro, IL. After serving in the United States Army during World War II, he and his wife settled in Pocomoke City in 1946. Mr. Wagner was originally employed by the Birdseye Division on the General Foods Corporation at Pocomoke and worked there from 1946 until moving to Easton in 1962. He then, was employed by the Esskay Company as the General Manager for poultry production until 1974. In 1971, he was appointed to the Delmarva Poultry Industry Council in by Governor Marvin Mandel. In 1974, Mr. Wagner joined the United States Department of Agriculture in the Farmers' Home Administration, where he served as a County Supervisor and loan administrator until his retirement in 1984.

Mr. Wagner lived in the South Clifton area of Easton until 2005. He was recently a resident of Heartfields Assisted Living at Easton. A lifetime member of the Elks Lodge B.P.O. 1622 of Easton, he and his wife, were active member of the Easton Dance Club. He made many friends in retirement while working as a Marshall at the Hog Neck Golf Course.

In addition to his wife of 65 years, he is survived by four children; David Wagner of Bowie, MD, Cheryl Baynard of Savannah, GA, Gail Carroll of Dunkirk, MD, and James Jeffery Wagner of Greensboro, MD. He is also survived by eight grandchildren and eleven great- grandchildren.

A Graveside service will be held on Wednesday, May 16, 2007, at the Maryland Eastern Shore Veterans Cemetery, Hurlock at 2:00 P.M.
