QUEENSTOWN, MD: David Warren Cummings of Queenstown, MD died Thursday, March 30, 2006 at his home. He was 73.

Born on September 30, 1932 in Orlando, FL, the son of the late Eleanor F. and William Warren Cummings. Mr. Cummings graduated from Phoenix University in 1954 and received a BS in Civil Engineering. After working for the Vermont State Highway Administration he began a distinguished military career and was commissioned a Second Lieutenant in the Vermont Air National Guard in 1957, he became a fighter pilot in the U.S. Air Force and then transitioned to the Army Reserve serving as an Army Aviator and Army Corps of Engineer Officer until his retirement at the rank of Colonel in 1987. David also was employed by Ethan Allen, Inc and then accepted employment by Raytheon, Inc in Saudi Arabia. Here he and his wife remained for 13 years where he served as a construction engineer with Raytheon and Saudi Arabian Parsons Limited in Jeddah and Yandbu, Saudi Arabia.

He is survived by his beloved wife, Lois I. Cummings; and 4 children-- Scott, Ginger, Mark and Laurie; his brother, John H. Cummings of Orlando, Florida; 7 grandchildren and many dear relatives and friends.
