Dawn Marie Walden Denny, 38, died at her home in Stevensville on August 13, 2006 after a long illness.

Born June 10, 1968 in Baltimore, she was the daughter of Robert F. Shortt and of the late Rhea Madeline Walden of Catonsville, and was raised by her maternal mother's sister, Verona M. Biller of Baltimore, with her brothers, Joshua S. Biller of Elkton and Eric D. Walden of Chester.
