April 22, 1934 - November 24, 2025

Dean H. Wood of Chestertown, MD passed away peacefully November 24, 2025, at The Resorts at Chester River Manor. He was 91.

Dean was born in Rock Hall, MD the son of the late Emmett H. and Bernice Lee Baker Wood. He was a 1952 graduate of Rock Hall High School, a 1956 graduate of Washington College where he earned a bachelor's degree in math, and a 1971 graduate of Loyola where he earned a master's degree in business administration. Dean was married to Anna Mae Jacquette, his high school sweetheart, on July 28, 1956. He served in the U.S. Army stateside. Dean and Anne Mae resided in Laurel, Bowie, Glenwood, Grasonville and Chestertown, MD. They also resided in Hawaii for a year while assisting the U.S. Navy to recover a Russian Submarine with Westinghouse Corporation. Dean worked with Westinghouse Corporation as an Engineer and in 1981 became the Software Department Manager, overseeing 300 employees. He retired in 1986 and consulted until 2005. He enjoyed golfing, gardening, crabbing, and fishing. Dean loved baseball, playing third base and pitching for Washington College. 1954 Dean and his team won the Mason Dixon Championship. He was a member of Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church and was deeply involved with the Gideons.

In addition to his parents Dean was preceded in death by his wife of 67 years Anna Mae Jacquette Wood in 2023.

He is survived by his son David Wood of Chestertown, MD, a brother Dale Wood of Glen Burnie, MD, along with numerous friends from over the years.

A memorial service will be held on Monday, December 8 at 1:00 pm at Wesley Chapel Methodist Church in Rock Hall.

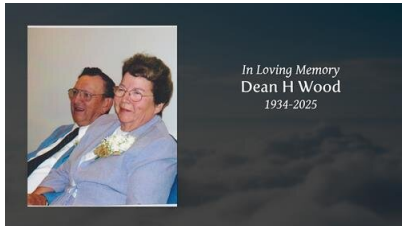
