Dean Edward Clark, of Easton, died at Genesis Eldercare – The Pines, Easton, on Sunday, February 13, 2005. He was 83.

Born in Alliance, Ohio, November 27, 1921, he was the son of the late Paul J. and Iona Pinkerton Clark. After graduating from Louisville, Ohio High School in 1939, he entered the U. S. Army. During World War II, he served in the European Theatre of Operations. During the Korean Conflict, he served in Korea with the Signal Corps and was awarded a Bronze Star among other decorations. After completion of his military service in 1962 with the rank of Major, he worked as a cryptologist with the National Security Agency with whom he had been associated while in the military. He retired from the Agency in 1964. From 1971 until 1976, he owned and operated the Village Book Store in Westminster, MD.

Prior to moving to Talbot County in April of 1988, he had lived in Westminster for twenty-five years where he was a member of the Westminster Elks Lodge #2277 where he served as Inner Guard for several years. A Civil War buff, he enjoyed reading and organic gardening.

Mr. Clark is survived by his wife, the former Marion A. Szyper whom he married September 4, 1954; three daughters, Rose A. Regan of Tilghman, Mary C. Pocock of Laurel, MD and Adele Clark and her husband, Larry Bosley, of Trappe and two granddaughters, Kate and Melissa Bosley.

Funeral services, with military honors, will be held at the graveside at Arlington National Cemetery, Arlington VA on Thursday, March 10, 2005 at 9:00 AM.
