



Dean Ellsworth Foote

September 23, 1924 - March 15, 2009

Dean Ellsworth Foote, 84, of Annapolis, formerly of Stevensville, MD, passed away at his home at Baywoods of Annapolis, on Sunday, March 15, 2009. Mr. Foote was born in Washington, D.C. on September 23, 1924 and was the son of the late Aubrey Ellsworth Foote and Mary (Sherwood) Foote.

Mr. Foote married Margaret (Peggy) Lewis on April 24, 1943. He served in the U.S. Army in the Pacific in three invasions, Boganville, Cebu and Layte and then Japan. His tour ended in 1945. After the war Mr. Foote graduated from Bell Vocational High School Class of 1947. He then completed an apprenticeship to become a union electrician. Mr. Foote worked for 43 years for the Local #26 Union in Washington, D.C. until he retired in 1990. Mr. Foote was a member of the Kent Island American Legion Post #278, BPO Elks Lodge #2576 of Stevensville, MD and the Island Idlers. He enjoyed boating and fishing and was a member of the Redskins Band. His main hobby was his family.

He is survived by his son, Dean Wayne Foote of Bowie, MD; two daughters, Donna Fletcher of Naples, FL and Dee Gendron and son-in-law, Paul Gendron of Cape Coral, FL; a granddaughter, Melinda Julie Sheffield and two great-grandchildren, David Scheafnocker and Cody Pucel. Mr. Foote was preceded in death by his wife, Margaret (Peggy) Foote, two grandchildren, Donna Marie Pucel and Michael Anthony Foote and his son-in-law John

Fletcher.
