Della V. Dunklin of Easton, MD died on Sunday, July 17, 2005 at the Memorial Hospital at Easton. She was 86.

Born in Wittman, MD on February 14, 1919, she was the daughter of the late Lloyd Lowe and Lucy Jones Lomax. After graduating from St. Michaels High School in 1936 she entered nurses training at the Easton Emergency Hospital School of Nursing where she graduated in 1942. From 1943 until 1946 she served as a U.S. Army Nurse in the Pacific Theatre of Operation, mostly in New Guinea. Following her release from active duty she made her home in Baltimore County where she did private duty nursing at Johns Hopkins Hospital until 1959. She then worked as a private duty nurse, companion and office secretary for a family in Baltimore City until retiring in 1979 at which time she moved to Easton.

A life member of the E. E. Streets Memorial Post #5118 VFW, she was also a member of the McQueen Gibbs Willis School of Nursing Alumni Association, an active member of the Talbot County Association for Retarded Citizens and a charter member of the WIMSA (Women in Military Service for America).

Mrs. Dunklin is survived by her daughter, Diane Lynne Dunklin of Easton, MD and several cousins.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday, July 21, 2005 at 2:00 p.m. at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A., Easton, MD.

Burial will be private.
