



## Delores Firebaugh O'Brien

August 26, 1932 - January 13, 2017

Delores Firebaugh O'Brien, age 84 resident of Charlestown Retirement Community and formerly of Kent Island, passed away on January 13, 2017.

Despite her long struggles for many years with COPD, she lived life to the fullest. She is no longer struggling to breathe and is in the loving care of her Lord and Savior. The reunion in heaven with her beloved relatives and friends brings us great peace and comfort. God truly blessed us in having her in our lives and family for so many years. Delores loved people and was very instrumental in organizing and gathering friends and family for outings and parties.

Born in Baltimore, MD, on August 26, 1932, she was the daughter of Gernie and Charlotte (Bock) Firebaugh. She graduated from Forest Park High School, Class of June 1950. Her federal career started at Fort George G. Meade, MD. She later went with the Social Security Administration, retiring as a Fiscal Management Analyst, after 37 years of service. During her career, she received numerous awards, including the DHHS Award and Commissioners Citations. She married Anthony "Alfie" O'Brien in September 1953. They moved to Chester, MD, in 1974. She was a member of St. Christopher's Catholic Church and held offices in various local organizations.

Delores is survived by a son, Terence (Cathy) O'Brien of Jarrettsville, MD; and

a daughter, Colleen (Buddy) Thomas of Stevensville, MD; two grandsons, Russell (Sara) and Cody Thomas; and three great-grandsons, Gavin, Sam, and Jake.

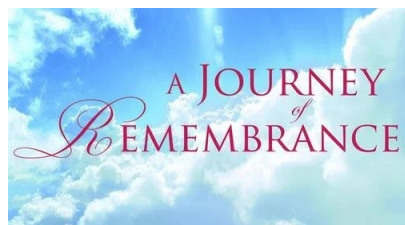

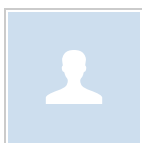
