



Delores "Dory" Fahey Miller

March 15, 1935 - September 20, 2008

Dolores "Dory" Fahey Miller, a retired teacher and active participant for many years in the Annapolis theater scene, passed away at Anne Arundel Medical Center in Annapolis, MD on Saturday, September 20, 2008. She was 73. Mrs. Miller was born in Baltimore, MD on March 15, 1935, and was the daughter of the late Richard Edwin Fahey and Annabelle (Atkinson) Fahey.

Mrs. Miller moved to Annapolis from Cumberland, MD, in 1957 after earning a bachelor's degree from Frostburg State University and taught in Anne Arundel County elementary schools for 30 years. She also earned a master's degree in fine arts from Johns Hopkins University.

Mrs. Miller discovered Colonial Players theater soon after coming to Annapolis, and it remained a big part of her life until her death. She was seen on stage in many productions in the Annapolis area over the years, mostly at Colonial Players, where she met her husband, Edd Miller. She first appeared at Colonial Players in "Gigi" in 1958 and was last seen in 2003 in "Over the River and Through the Woods."

Mrs. Miller loved traveling and various forms of sewing and needlework, especially quilting.

She is survived by her husband, who lives in Annapolis; a niece, Brigita Miles of Cockeyville, MD and two great nephews, Daniel Bradley II of Pasadena, MD and Zachary Murphy of Cockeyville, MD.

A celebration of Mrs. Miller's life will be held at the Blue Heron Center at Quiet Waters Park, 600 Quiet Waters Park Road, Annapolis, MD 21403 on Wednesday, October 8, 2008 at 3:30 p.m. Interment will be private.
