



Dennis Kevan Dill

November 16, 1959 - January 26, 2024

Dennis K. Dill, 64 of Stevensville, MD., died at his home on Friday, January 26, 2024, from the effects of Alzheimer's.

Dennis was born in Greenbelt, MD on November 16, 1959, the son of Floyd & Gladys Dill.

Dennis attended both Greenbelt Elementary and Mary Bethune Elementary, and eventually graduated from Parkdale High School. In 1977, Dennis joined the United States Navy, where he was stationed in Hawaii and served for 4 years. After his enlistment was up, he began working for the Prince George's County School System in the maintenance division, eventually working his way up to supervisor and HVAC technician. Dennis retired on July 1st, 2012, and during his retirement kept busy working a part-time job at Food Lion.

Dennis was very fond of being on the water and owned a 26' Sea Swirl Fishing Boat. He participated in many tournaments and won several trophies and awards.

Dennis is survived by his loving wife Helena, his Brother-In-Laws Sean and Richard, and some extended family on the West Coast.

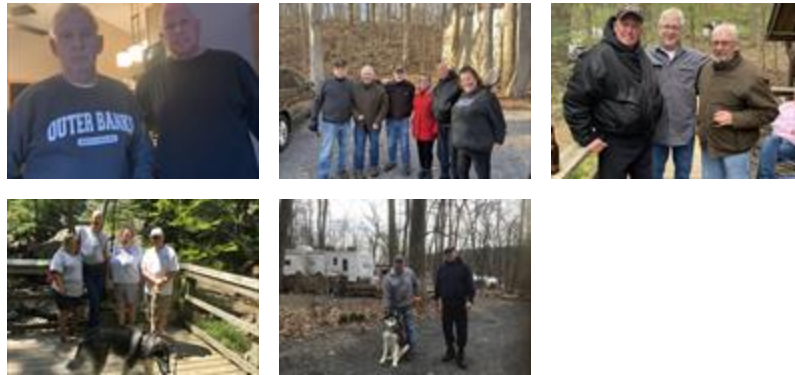
