

Dennis A. McAuliffe

January 21, 1945 - June 17, 2013

Dennis “Butch” McAuliffe died on June 17, 2013, at his home. He was 68.

He was born on January 21, 1945, in Annapolis, MD, to the late John E. and Mary Hittle McAuliffe.

Butch attended public school in Anne Arundel County, and then attended Barber School in Baltimore, MD. After graduation, he joined the National Guard and began his lifelong career of fifty years as a barber at the Eastport Barber Shop. He was an active member of the Easton Elks Lodge # 1622, the American Legion, Tuckahoe Steam & Gas Show, and the Antique Automobile Club of America.

He truly enjoyed restoring antique cars, traveling to car shows, boating, fishing, riding his motorcycle and was an avid “tinkerer” in his barn, while listening to music from the 50’s.

Butch is survived by the love of his life, Carol Rose McAuliffe; his sister, Miriam Hensley (Mainos); a nephew, Wayne Hensley (JoEllen); and a niece, Cyndi Hensley.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his son, David John Rose.

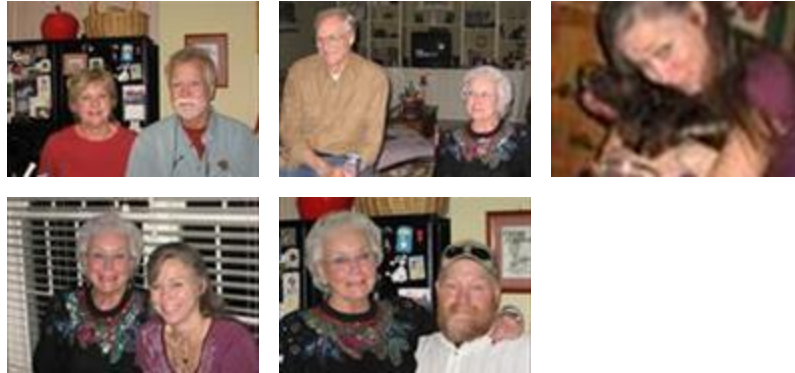

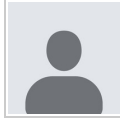

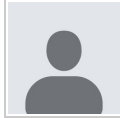
